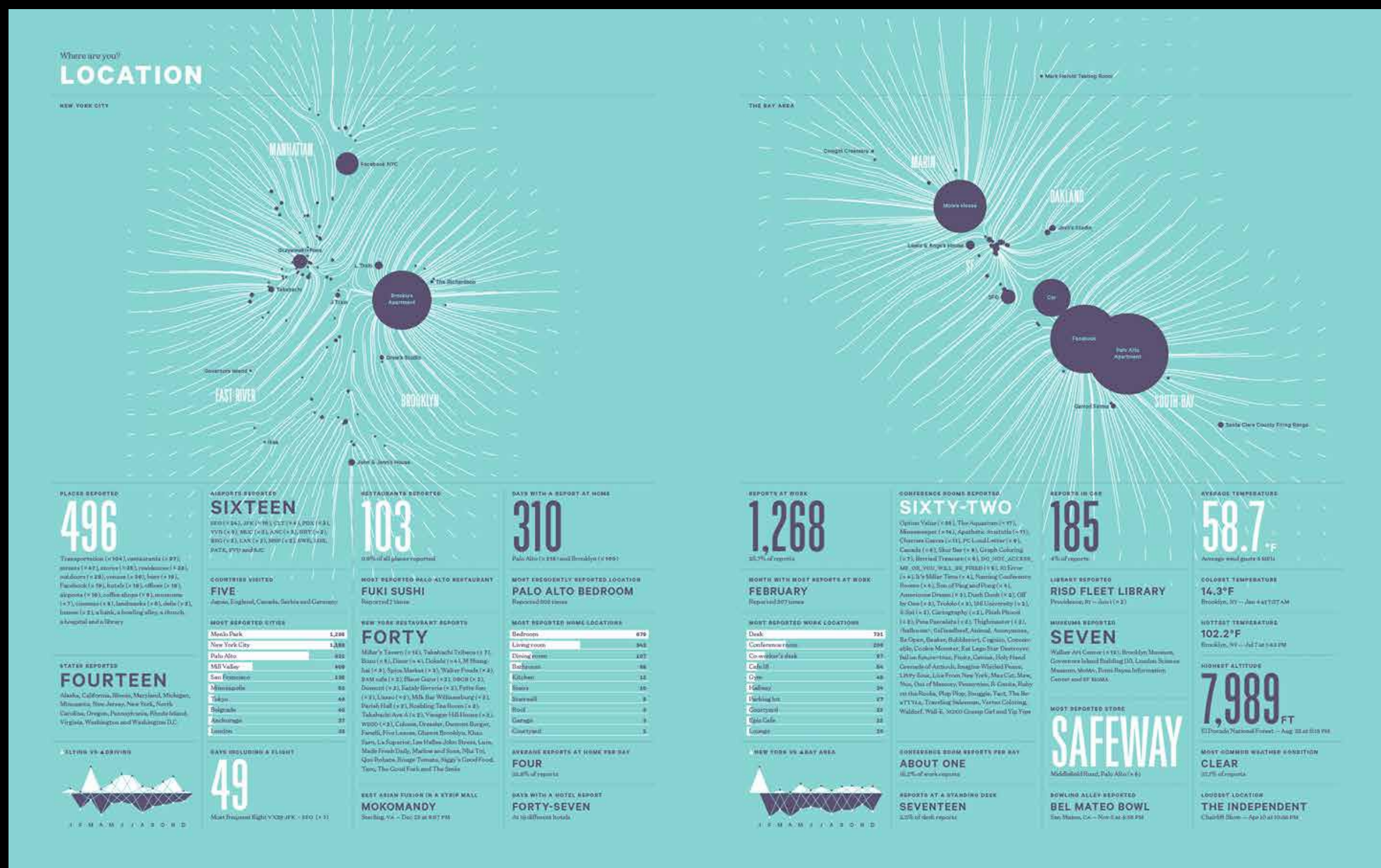


Interaction Assignment Proposal 1

Subject:

daily life emotions departmentalisation occurrences

I was inspired by the Feltron Project, created by graphic designer Nicholas Felton. His annual reports (produced from 2005 to 2012) give an overview of his year in a variety of data visualisations. We see where he has travelled, who he has talked to, how many alcoholic beverages he has consumed, and even his DJ-ing to Dancing Ratio. The data that he amasses from personal diaries, calendars, photos and online histories are edited down and displayed in a punchy, infographic style:



I enjoy that both quantitative and qualitative data are displayed in this in-depth study and departmentalisation of a human being. For example, a graph showing hours of sleep per night may sit adjacent to Felton's judgement of the day's productivity (49.6%!) Long-term trends in food or travel are also shown next to random occurrences such as:

"Insect Infestations Disturbed: ONE. Moths feasting on sweaters at mini-storage."

"First Grey Hair Discovered: 20th June 2006."

I intend to create my own 1-week report, meaning that I will be responsible for collecting my own data between Tuesday 22 April and Monday 28 April, 2014. Some areas to be considered include:
